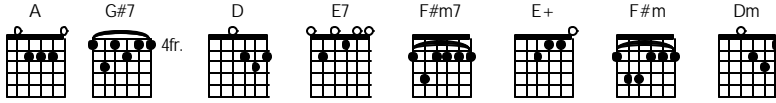


I'm So Tired
