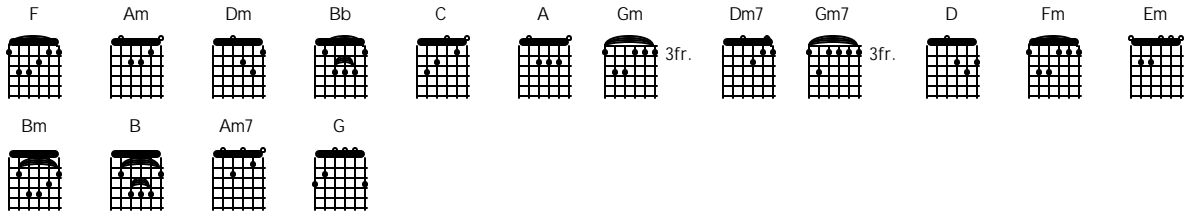


I Dreamed A Dream
