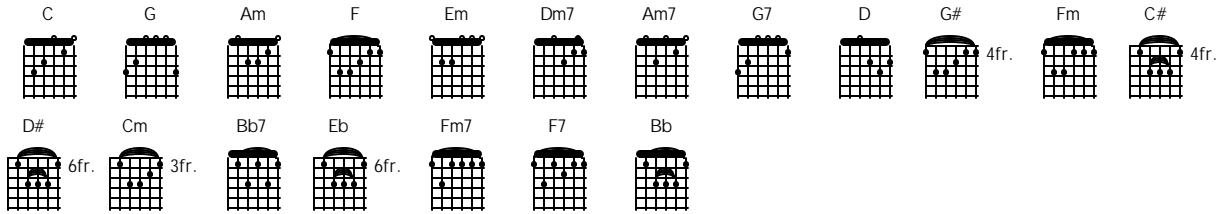


# Memory
