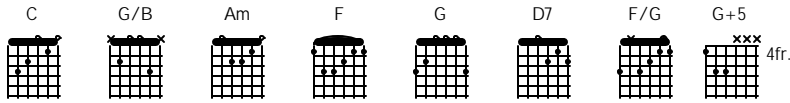


# When a Man Loves a Woman
